Course Description

This one-day workshop provides students the ability to use and develop a digital portfolio for the school of education requirement using Weebly (weebly.com). The instructor will introduce the basics of digital portfolios, how to plan and organize their digital portfolio and a demonstration on how to use Weebly to build their digital portfolio. Students will move beyond the traditional models of information distribution using image, sound, motion and text.

Course Goals

- To demonstrate individual proficiency with the different types of technology that can be used to create multimedia presentations
- To demonstrate proficiency of the application of message design to the development of multimedia productions
- To demonstrate proficiency with a variety of components that can be integrated into a multimedia production
- To demonstrate proficiency of current software applications available for multimedia development along with a basic proficiency for using the applications

Course Objectives

- Students will be able to use at least three different multimedia applications for the development of messages.
- Students will be able to demonstrate the process of message design to a multimedia project by completing assigned individual or group projects.
- Students will demonstrate the ability to incorporate intermediate graphic design skills in the development of several assigned multimedia projects, either as individuals or team members.
- Students will be able to demonstrate proficiency in incorporation of a variety of media types into assigned projects.
- Students will use current software applications to develop a multimedia project for a client, either as an individual or team member.
